The Office of the University Registrar and the Next Generation Student Systems (NGSS) project are pleased to announce the availability of Curriculum Manager (CM). The August 28, 2019 release marked the University of Pennsylvania's transition to a curriculum management process that is automated and adaptable to meet each School's needs.

Curriculum Manager is used by faculty and staff to modify, track, and approve new and existing courses and programs. CM uses electronic forms and workflows to manage the curricular approval process.

The value this new application provides the University was best expressed by Mike O'Brien, Associate Director, Student Records, Wharton Undergraduate Division:

Curriculum Manager shows so much potential for the management of courses and programs within the Wharton Undergraduate Division and the University as a whole.
